How it works

Work Reimagined offers a flexible menu of creative workshop options designed to suit different group sizes, timeframes, and levels of engagement.

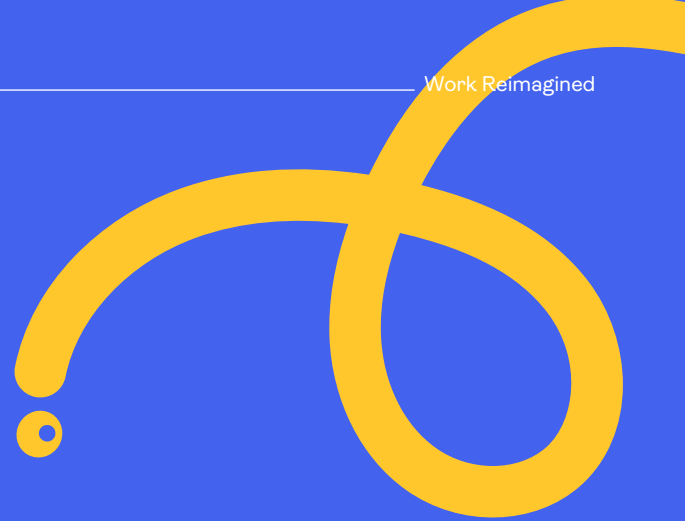
Activities are divided into **Small, Medium** and **Large** experiences, allowing you to build a bespoke programme that best fits your team and objectives.

Small experiences are short, accessible, and creative exercises that typically take 15-30 minutes and are ideal for quick recharge breaks, conference activations or introductory sessions.

Medium experiences are more immersive, skill-based workshops lasting approximately 60 minutes, giving participants the opportunity to explore techniques such as painting, printmaking or felting in a relaxed and supportive environment.

Large experiences are collaborative, team-focused experiences that encourage creativity, communication, and connection through the creation of a shared artwork or installation that can be displayed within the workplace afterwards.

You can mix and match from the Small, Medium and Large experiences depending on your time frame and group size. This menu approach allows you and Helium to tailor each experience to the needs, energy and goals of your organisation, while ensuring sessions remain inclusive, engaging and led by you.

Small Experiences



Bite-size Collage

Exactly as it sounds, Bite-sized Collage challenges participants to make collages on a small scale using A5 or smaller paper. An opportunity to upcycle paper and card, this activity requires very little space but opens a world of imagination for participants to cut, stick, glue, rip, test different colours, textures, compositions on a manageable size of cardstock. For those who hesitate to create, this is a great way for people to ease into the experience.



Whimsy Sculpture

Challenged to think outside the box, participants will need to use their imagination to test out and combine a random mish-mash of fun objects and things that they will receive in a box. Whimsy sculpture is composed of miscellaneous objects such as beads,



paper, and plastic pieces which can be threaded through wire. Each box contains different things; participants are encouraged to get chatting and exchange materials.

Magpie Plate

If we were magpies, what kind of plate would we use for our supper? This activity will ask participants to gather some of their favourite items from around and outside their home and bring them in to embed into air-dry clay to form a treasure-encrusted plate fit for a magpie. We'll have a take-one, leave one box where participants can trade items for other items to add to their creation.

Medium Experiences



Block Printing

This project adds a little dimensional twist on printmaking by introducing the cube. A collage of materials come together with a cube to create a fun, dimensional printing activity. Participants will layer, manipulate, paint and print to get a variety of prints from a cube, an activity which is great for collaboration but also a chance to add individual flair.



Felted Pebbles

For those who miss their childhood pet rock, here's another chance to make another. In this hands-on, practically mess-free activity, participants will wet-felt their very own rock using a freezer bag, roving, soap and water. Participants who want to stay clean can use the freezer bag method while those who want to get soapy can join in using our alternative method. This is a simple activity which creates a lovely take home keepsake.

Large Experiences



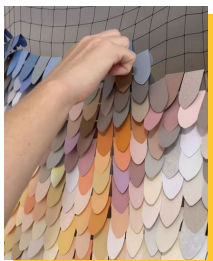
Canvas Carousel

Canvas Carousel involves an individual or team painting on a canvas for a set amount of time. When that time is up, the canvas is then passed onto the next team for them to add onto. This continues until the group gets their original canvas back. This can work for small and large groups. At the end, participants receive a beautiful canvas which everyone has contributed to.



Busy Bee Sculpture

A sculptured shape is created out of wire and working together as a group or with individual sculptures; rolls of paper are inserted into the holes to create a unique showcase of colours. This project is scalable and easily accommodates small to large groups as well as individuals. It's easy to get started and can be a company-wide effort that lives on in the workplace.



Dragon Scale Sculpture

Cut out of colourful paper made from various types of paper and magazines, participants combine circles to create a colourful array on a canvas, board, or netting/fencing. The paper used for this activity can be company material such as old brochures or flyers for example. Reuse and Recycle!



Hirameki Mural

Hirameki means "brainwave" or "flash of inspiration" in Japanese. In this Hirameki Mural activity, participants will make different ink blots. Afterwards, they will add lines and shapes to create faces, figures, creatures and objects from their imagination. Easy to start but also challenging for people who are used to creating.
